LEVEL TWO

This is an introductory course designed for people new to support work. It aims to develop the entry-level skills and knowledge required to provide person-centred support safely in the health and wellbeing sectors.

After completion of this course your support worker will be able to:

- Work within the responsibilities and boundaries their role.
- Perform entry-level person-centred tasks.
- Recognise and report risks and changes.
- Communicate to support a person's health or wellbeing.

You and your support worker can choose the unit standards that are the most relevant to your support needs.

LEVEL THREE

This programme aims to develop the skills and knowledge required to support and empower people in home and community settings. It is for people who are employed as support workers and who are wanting to further develop their skills and knowledge.

Your support worker does not have to have Level Two in order to enroll on this course.

After completion of this course your support worker will be able to:

- Recognise and respond to signs of vulnerability and abuse in a health or wellbeing setting.
- Demonstrate ethical and professional behaviour in a health or wellbeing setting.
- Provide person-centred support to maximise independence.
- Recognise and respond to change.

You and your support worker can choose the unit standards that are the most relevant to your support needs.

Funding

A Training Grant is available from Te Pou which Manawanui can help you access. The maximum grant amount available for Level Two is \$400 and for Level Three \$600.

This grant will only cover a portion of the total cost. Your Individualised Funding (EIF, EGL, IF) can be used to cover the balance.
